2. Branding and Marketing for SD 10 –

- a. Last revision of logo and brand – 20 years ago
- b. SD 10 Brochure and DVD completed June 27th 2014
- c. Awaiting all parent media consents before public distribution of films, brochures, uploading to website YouTube channel (not all yet completed due to strike)
- d. Major upgrades and revisions to the SD 10 website have been made, with additional work ongoing
- e. All school websites are now created or updated and will be regularly updated with school-managed content
- f. Letterhead, business cards and logos completed
- g. SD 10 sign in front of Board Office and vehicle decals in process

3. Strike Update

- a. BCTF full strike in effect; CUPE members not crossing picket lines; students have not been at school since Friday, June 13th
- b. Significant impact of the strike for parents and students, for our employees, on maintenance and operations, and our community
- c. Board of Education letters sent June and August 2014 to Minister Fassbender and BCTF; trustees and senior staff continue to lobby for a timely resolution to the dispute and a fair settlement
- d. Positive and respectful relationship between SD10 and both unions
- e. Teachers not locked out by BCPSEA, and access to their schools is not restricted by the district; BCTF advised teachers not to enter schools
- f. International program orientation and enriched cultural program for 3 students from China – not educational program
- g. Preschool co-located at Lucerne School may open with non-picketed entrance agreed to by ALTA
- h. BC School Sports announcement – community coaches will be allowed to use school facilities and equipment with P/VPs monitoring safety
