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TOP TEN SAFETY RULES ON BUSES

Please do:

1. Talk and act with respect and courtesy("Please" and "Thank you" always appreciated)
2. Sit quietly and properly-on seat, feet on floor, face forward
3. Keep your hands to yourself and inside the bus (no handing out windows)
4. Stay in your assigned seat and keep the aisle clear
5. Put litter in a garbage can
6. Board and leave the bus safely-walk, cross only in front to the bus wand watch for traffic always
7. Provide permission note (signed by parent/guardian) to change your bus stop-for visits to friends, birthday parties, work, etc.
8. Use common sense to model good behavior for others
9. Smile-you may be on video camera
10. Treat others as you would like to be treated

Please don't:

1. Disobey or distract your bus driver
2. Assault, bully, threaten, intimidate or harass others
3. Swear, be rude, and/or disrespectful to others
4. Bring weapons of any kind on board
5. Bring alcohol or illegal drugs on board
6. Smoke/chew tobacco or use lighters or matches
7. Vandalize-you or your parents will pay for the damages
8. Litter or make a mess and privileges will be lost
9. Throw anything anytime
10. Play with emergency exits or equipment

All incidents of misbehavior on school busses will be reported in writing by the driver to the Principal who will notify parents/guardian. Repeat or serious offenses will result in seat reassignment and/or suspension of bus riding privileges. Please be advised that in the spring of 2004 the School Board approved the installation of video surveillance cameras on District buses to help ensure safety, order, and discipline to prevent vandalism.
