### Annual Inventory of Hazardous Materials FORM

**Overview:**

“Hazard” is the harm that something can cause. The harm be a physical injury, damage to health, property and/or the environment. Hazard is intrinsic or “built-in” characteristic. In WHIMIS we talk about hazardous materials, materials that can produce harm.

**The WHIMIS hazard classes (and possible harm they can cause) are:**

- Compressed gas (exploding containers)
- Flammable and combustible materials (fire)
- Oxidizing material (feeds a fire)
- Material causing immediate and serious toxic effects (e.g. death)
- Material causing other toxic effects (e.g. irritation, respiratory sensitization or cancer)
- Corrosive material (destruction of skin or metals)
- Dangerously reactive material (e.g. explosive reaction)
