- 5. Notice of award will take place over the week of April 26-30, 2021. Only successful bidders will be contacted. The information provided on this form will be used as the contact method.
- 6. Payment of all items must be made prior to, or the day of picking up items.
- 7. All items are required to be picked up from the site no later than Thursday May 13, 2021. Arrangements for pick up must be made in advance with Art Olson.
- 8. For the April 19, 2021 on-site viewing of auction items, COVID Safety Protocols will be implemented, and all prospective visitors are asked to adhere to the protocols as follows:
 - a. Persons feeling unwell or experiencing any COVID-19 related symptoms are required to stay home and not attend the viewing.
 - b. All visitors will be asked to sign in at the entrance to the yard and will be required to confirm that they have conducted a daily health check for COVID-19 symptoms.
