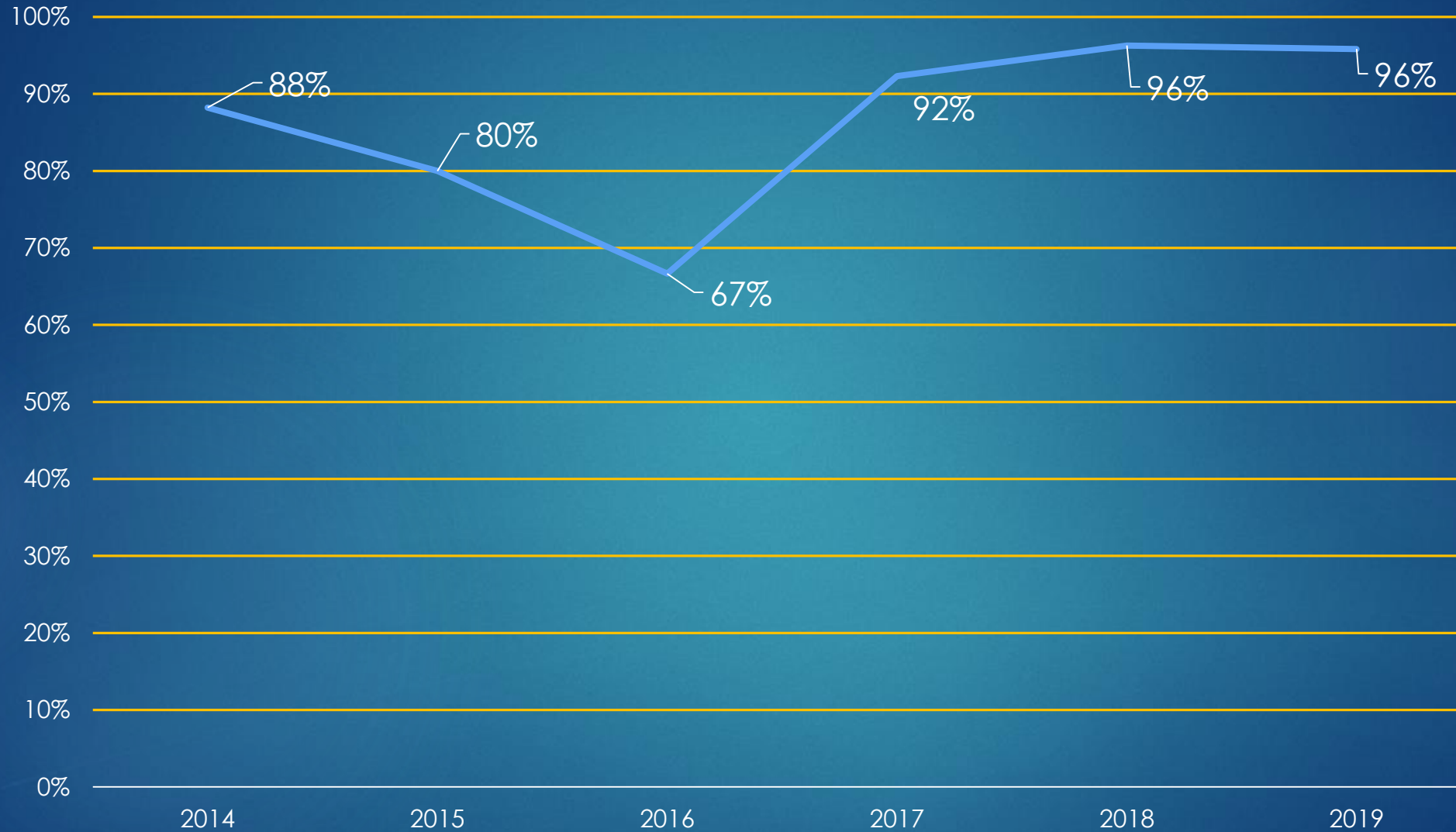

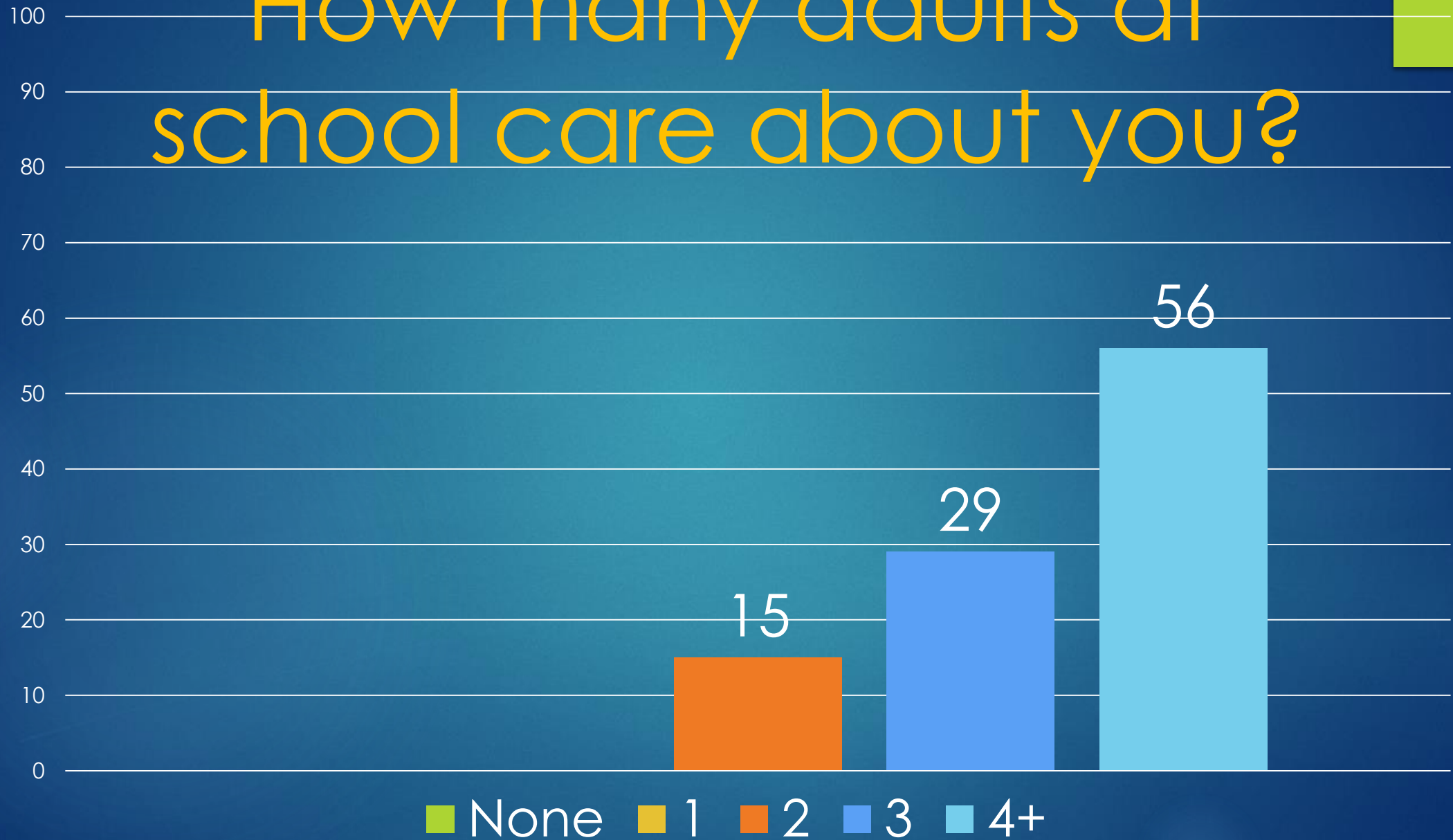

- Food, sports, house teams and clubs are seen as important parts in supporting student well-being



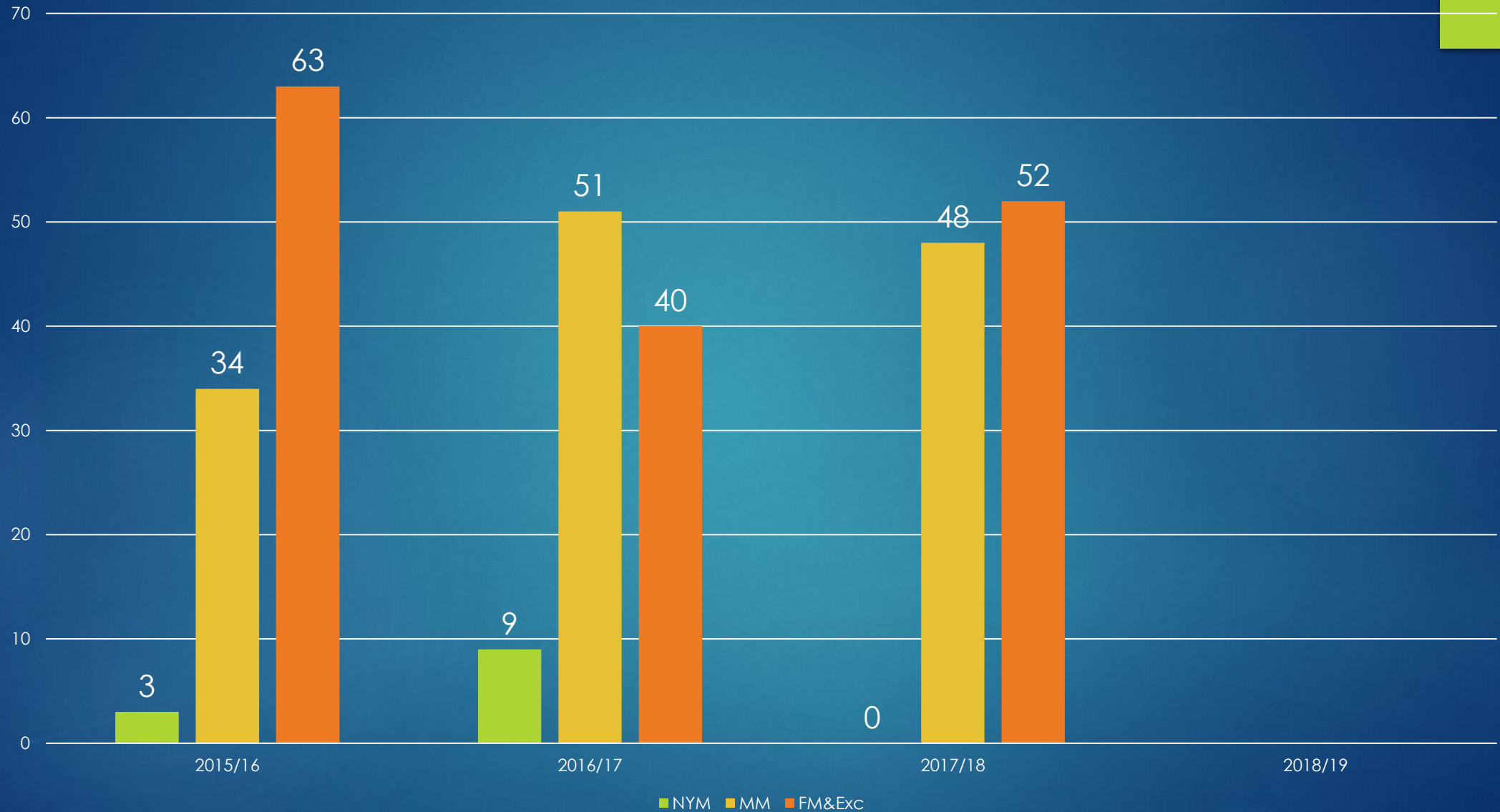

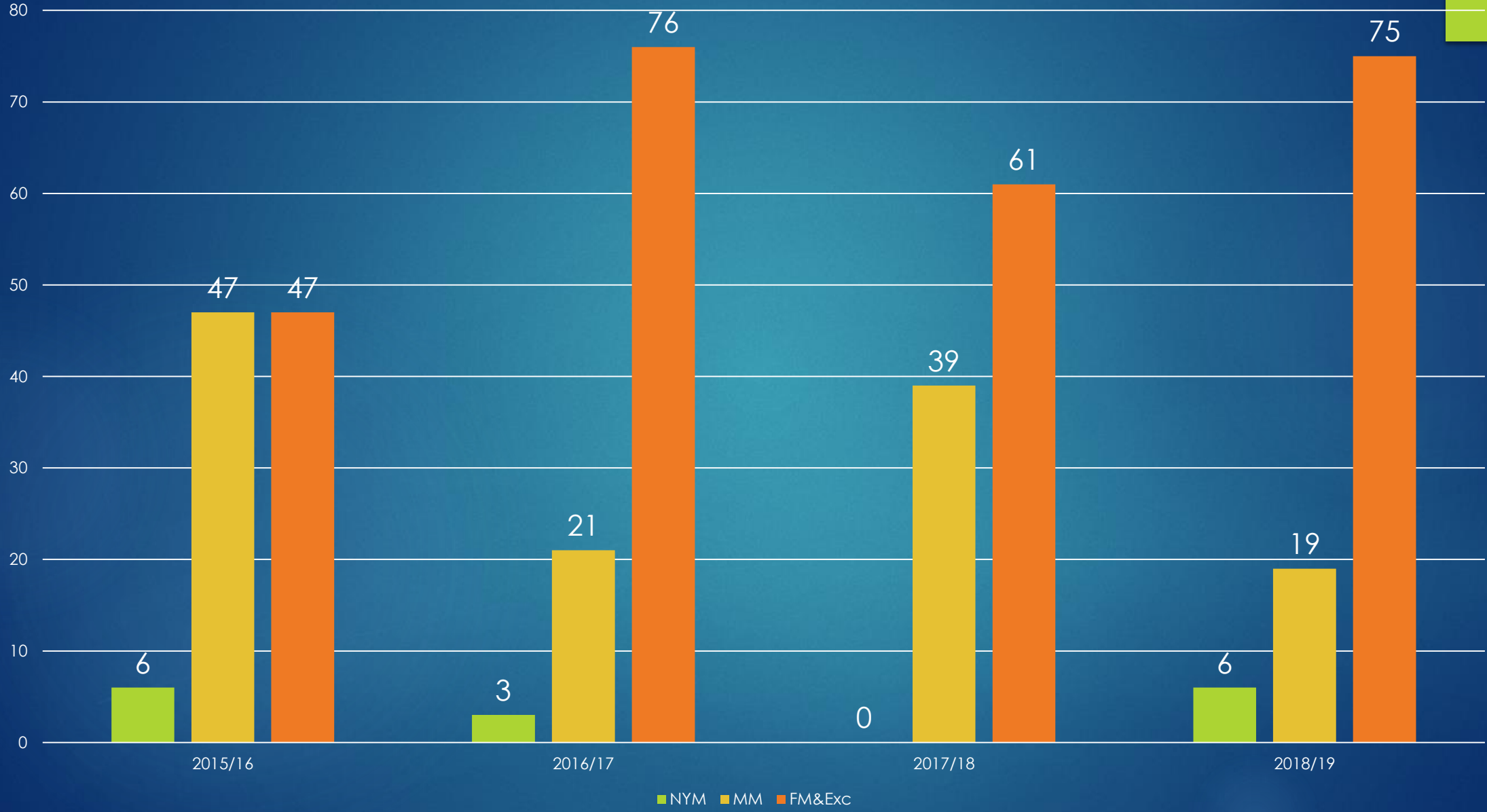

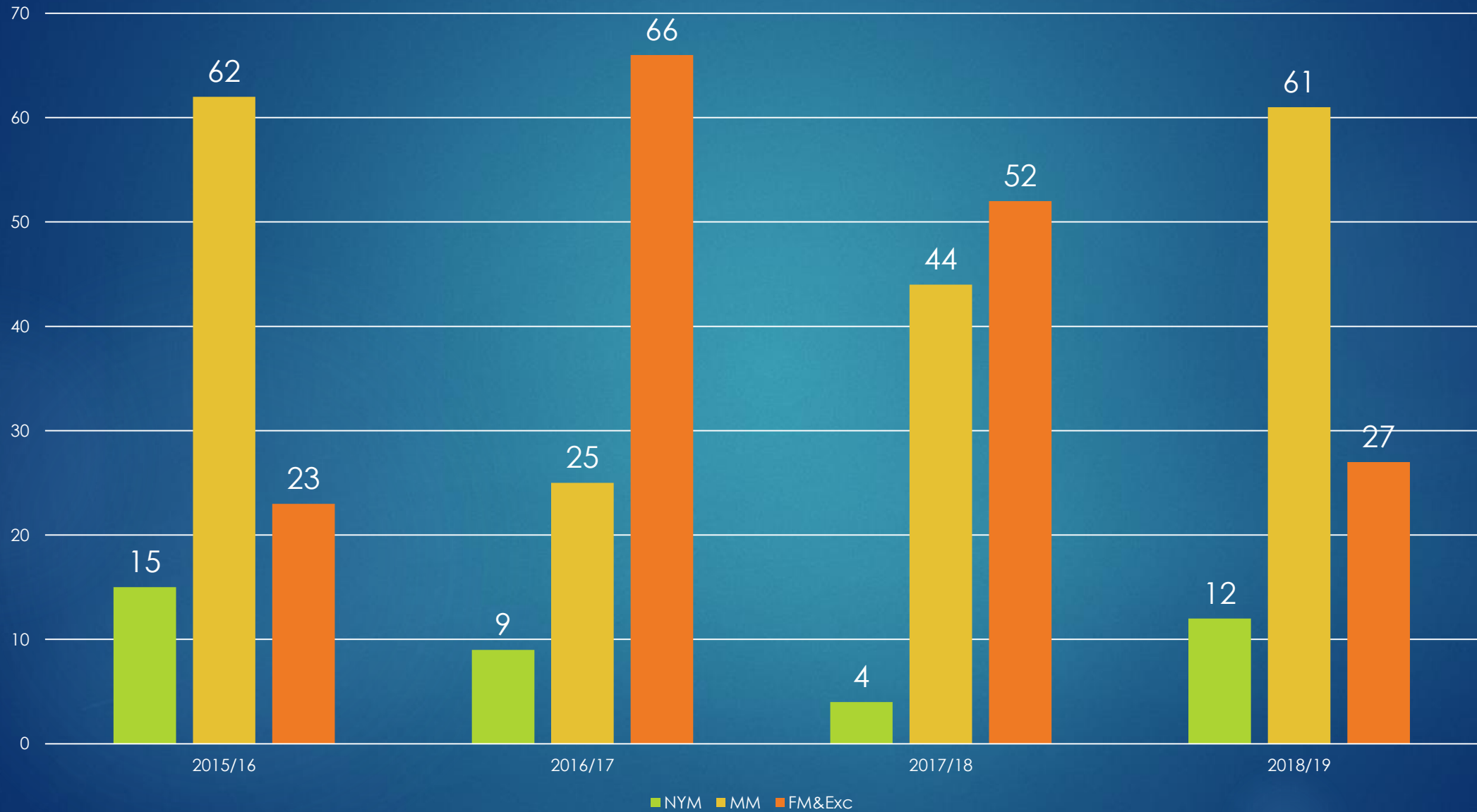
Grads of 2020 - Writing



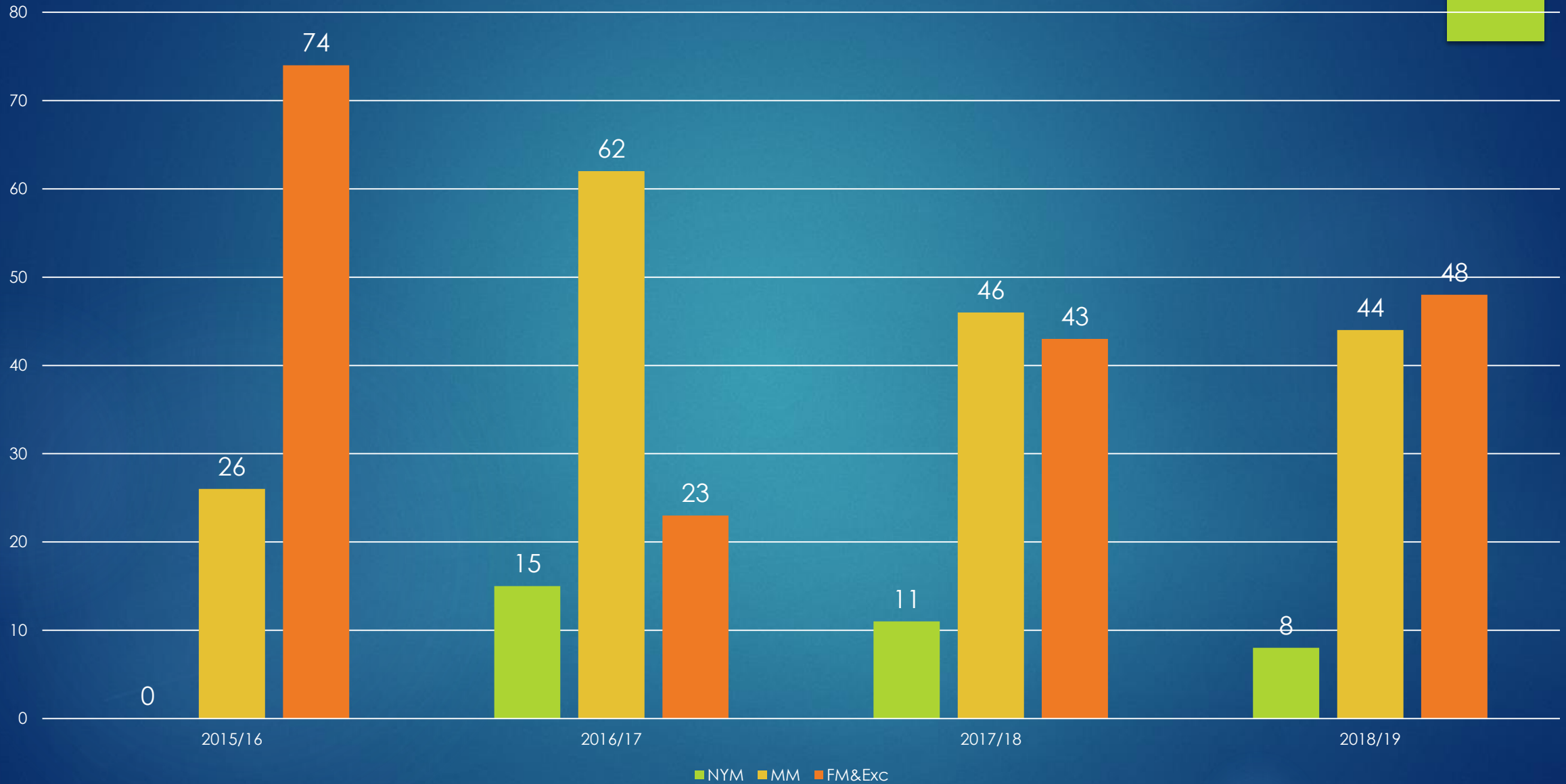
Grad 2021 - Writing



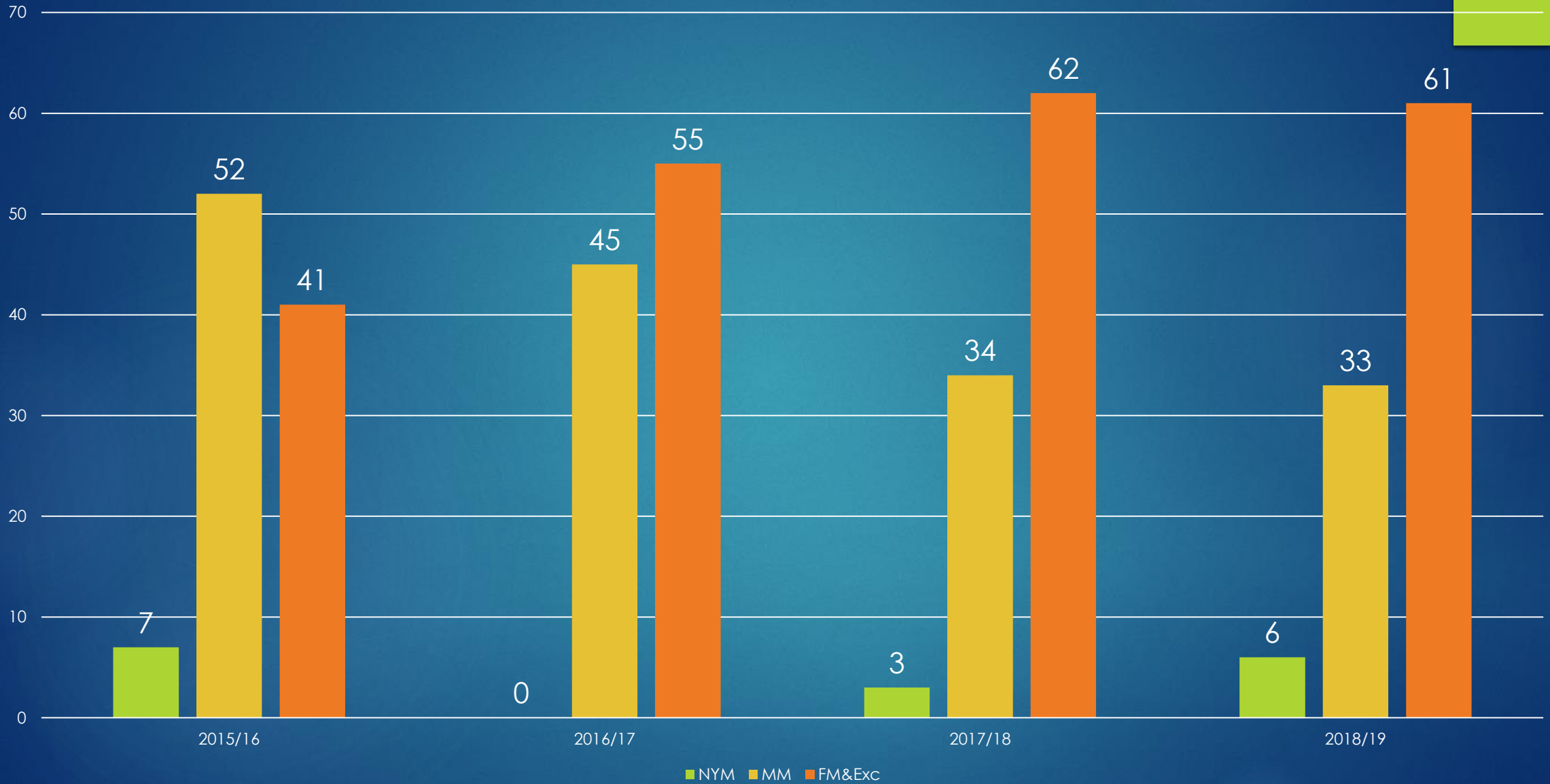
Grads 2022 - Writing



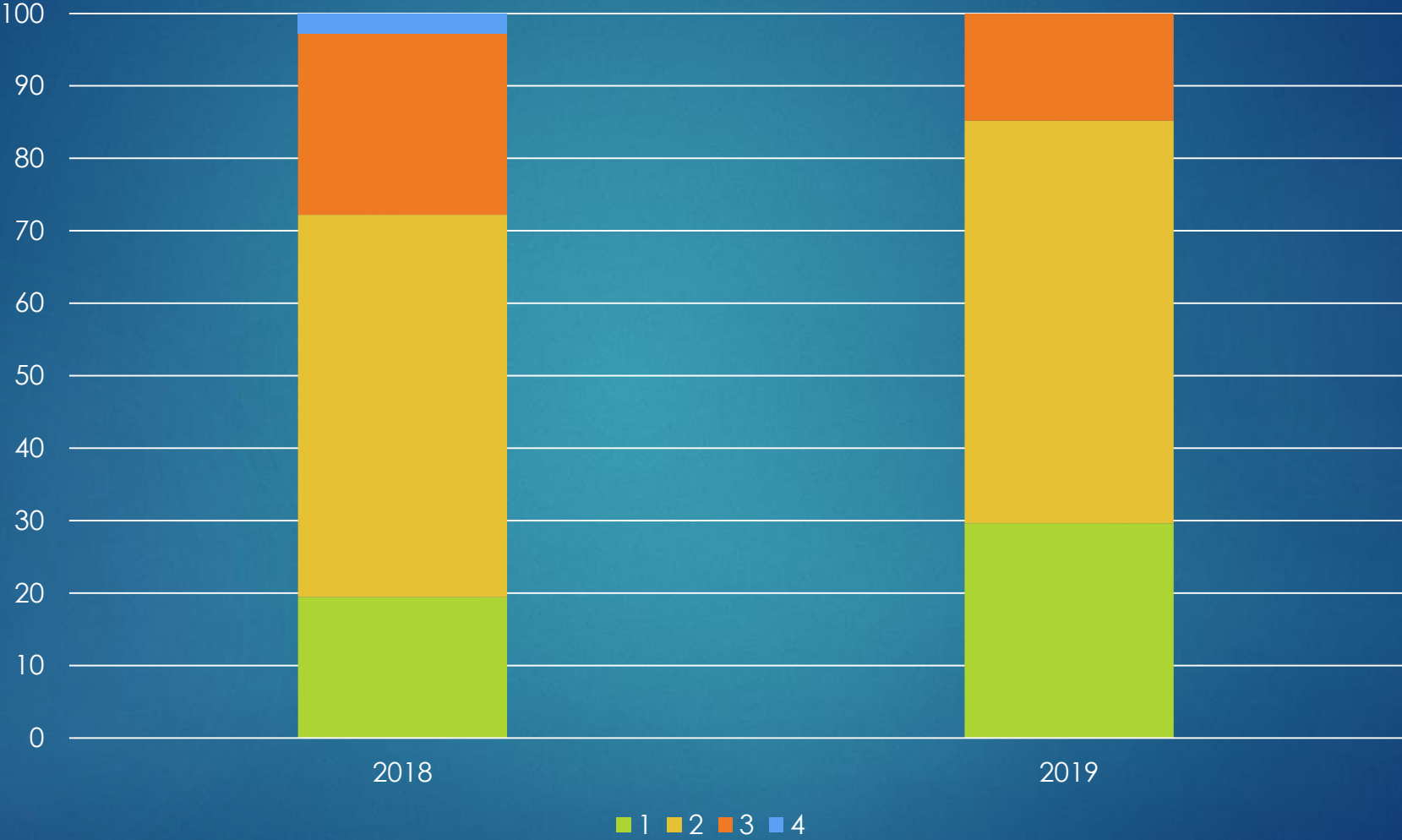

Graduation Numeracy Assessment Results



KEY LEARNINGS FROM DATA

- Writing: See an overall decrease in NYM by cohorts. Similar results in Reading
- Overall math scores are good but flat
 - School GNA scores are better than provincial average for GNA
- GLA formally starting in 2020 → new data
