ELECTOR REGISTRATION

Elector Registration

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. To register you must meet the following qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding voting day
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the School District 10(Arrow Lakes) for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day, and
- not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

To register, resident electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

To register, non-resident property electors must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from other property owners.

- 1) Full name,
- 2) Residential address,
- 3) Address of the property in relation to which you are voting (for non-resident property electors),
- 4) Method of delivery of your mail ballot package:
 - pick up at School District 10(Arrow Lakes) Board Office, OR
 - regular letter mail through Canada Post to residential address, OR
 - regular letter mail through Canada Post to an alternate address that you provide when requesting the ballot package,
- 5) If you are not on the list of electors, to ensure you receive the correct registration application form in your package, you must indicate whether you are going to be registering as a resident or non-resident property elector.

The School District #10 (Arrow Lakes) Board Office will send out mail ballot packages commencing on or about Monday, August 24, 2020. To be counted, your mail ballot must be received by the Chief Election Officer no later than 5:30 PM on Friday, September 11, 2020.
