Here are how things are going around the district.

- Southern Zone Outreach StrongStart has regular participants in all three sites. There are 16 preschool children enrolled. Parents are very thankful to have a gathering place to let their preschool children play & build relationships with other families. The Kindergarten students are a wonderful addition to the BES program Tuesday's 12-3. We are having a joyous time creating holiday crafts. The gym at EES & BES remains a popular activity for the youngsters.
- StrongStart in New Denver is going well, and families are happy to be back at school. Recently, we had Liam Fitzpatrick from COINS (Circle of Indigenous Nations) join us for a drumming experience with Grandmother Drum. Currently, we are busy crafting for the holidays and our favorite circle time activity includes using instruments to sing and act out the nursery rhyme: Hickory, Dickory, Dock.
- NES StrongStart is going strong with 57 children enrolled. With the reno's and covid, we are so lucky to have been running StrongStart in the gym. We have 6 families at a time, and they register online. Families have been enjoying the time. I make up snack bags for them also. On outreach days I speak to families on the phone and by text and messenger and I also prepare 52 theme bags that go out bi-weekly. A weekly theme bag consists of: 2 crafts I put together, a story the family can read and do together, coloring sheets, and information for science/songs/physical activities/recipes etc.
