Subject: Annual Capital Plan Bylaw No. 2021/22-CPSD10-02

## Purpose

To respectfully request that the Board of Trustees receive the background information supporting the amendment to the 2021/22 Annual Capital Plan Bylaw for information. Further that the Annual Programs Funding Agreement (Amended) be signed by the Board Chair on behalf of the Board of Trustees and lastly that Capital Plan Bylaw No. 2021/22-CPSD10-02 be given three readings and be adopted as requested by the Ministry of Education (Capital Branch).

## Background

On September 16, 2021, District staff received a letter from the Association of School Transportation Services of British Columbia (ASTSBC) confirming funding from the GO Electric Bus program for the SD10 electric bus purchase. Specifically, a 33% funding grant of \$118,625 for 2 of the 3 electric bus purchases for a total of \$237,250 was approved. Additionally, funding for the charging stations amounting to \$6,000 each for a total of \$18,000 was approved.

Also, on October 22, 2021, an Amended Ministry Response letter was received from the Capital Management Branch informing the district that \$495,400 through the Bus Program, \$90,000 in Supplemental funding and \$50,000 through the CNCP program was approved.

An updated table of the funding and costs related to the Electric Bus purchase is provided for your information.

It should be noted that all these funding sources were included in the Electric bus proposal originally approved by the Board in June except for the additional funding of \$67,417 needed to balance the updated schedule. This higher than anticipated need for funding is due to the higher pricing for the EV stations (originally budgeted at \$10K each). Staff will follow up by applying for the additional funding from ASTSBC and WC Bus. Any remaining funds needed to balance the





purchase can be provided funded through unspent AFG and Bylaw Capital as confirmed by Ministry staff.

The confirmation of approved funding by the Ministry and in accordance with Section 143 of the School Act, requires the Board to adopt a Capital Bylaw in response to the amended funding included in the October 22, 2021 Capital Plan Response Letter.

Following three readings and adoption of the Bylaw by the Board, the required signatories will be added to the funding agreement and the bylaw, and both will be submitted to the Capital Management Branch as requested.

## Recommendation

That the Board of Education for School District 10 (Arrow Lakes) approve Capital Bylaw No. 2021/22-CPSD10-02 which includes the updated and approved funding of \$635,400 (Bus program), \$90,000 (Supplemental), and \$50,000 (CNCP program) for the Electric Bus purchases as specified in the current Ministry Response letter and Annual Programs Funding Agreement.
