

SCHOOL DISTRICT NO.10 (ARROW LAKES)

Policy 300 – School/Program Registration & Catchments

General

- 1.1 The Board supports and encourages students and their parents or guardians who wish the student to receive an education in the community in which they reside. At the same time, the District's registration process shall provide the opportunity for a student and their parent or guardian to choose the school and education program that best meets the student's educational needs.
- 1.2 A student may enroll in any educational program at any school in the District, providing that the registration application is received by a specified date and there is space, as required by Sections 2(2) and 74.1 of the School Act, and by this Policy and related Protocols.
- 1.3 School catchments shall be established as required by Section 75.1 of the School Act to best meet the program needs of students, and to make the best use of facilities, staff, and transportation.

<u>Authorization</u>

- 1.4 The Superintendent is authorized to establish protocols for:
 - 1.4.1 Determining available space and facilities at schools and for school programs.
 - 1.4.2 Enrolment in schools/programs, and the order in which student applications for enrolment are accepted.
 - 1.4.3 Delineating catchment boundaries for each school.
