Protocol 680.2 – Student Transportation – Bus Routes

## Bus Routes and Bus Stops

- 1.1 Bus routes and bus stops will be reviewed annually and adjusted as needed, to provide quality and effective transportation services to as large number of students as possible.
- 1.2 Bus routes and bus stops will be updated as needed each year following school start up and once student ridership is confirmed.
- 1.3 Routes may be created where there is deemed to be sufficient students to justify providing school bus transportation, where road conditions and bus maneuvering are deemed safe and suitable.

- 1.5 Bus routes will be advertised in August each year in both the Arrow Lake News and Valley Voice newspapers.

## Requests for Bus Stops

- 1.6 A parent or guardian can request a bus stop by making a request to the Manager of Operations & Transportation in writing or by email to <u>Transportation@sd10.bc.ca</u>. Requests must include:
  - 1.6.1 Student home address(es).
  - 1.6.2 Requested bus stop location.
  - 1.6.3 Nearest existing bus stop location.
  - 1.6.4 Number students who would use the proposed new bus stop.
  - 1.6.5 Any other factors that may need to be taken into consideration (e.g. highway, winter conditions, etc.
