Introduction/Background

The Policy Committee of the Board, formed on February 21, 2023, was created with two purposes: (1) to assist the Board in fulfilling its goals and objectives by governing through policy development and adoption, and (2) to create a comprehensive and useful set of Board policies to guide district operations.

Proposed and Recommended Changes in Policy

<u>Current Proposed Changes in Policy</u>

Policy 501 – Staffing, Class Size and Complexity in Class Composition

• The Policy Committee has reviewed <u>Policy 501 – Staffing, Class Size and Complexity in Class Composition</u>. This policy is currently unused by the District and it is redundant and conflicting with the BCTF collective agreement and Ministry of Education and Child Care regulations. It is recommended that the policy be rescinded.

Various Policies - Housekeeping

• Various polices refer to the "Superintendent/Secretary-Treasurer", which is a position that no longer exists in the District. The position of Superintendent has replaced the Superintendent/Secretary-Treasurer as the position to which the Board delegates and confers authority to oversee the operations of the District. It is recommended that these policies are updated to change where it is written "Superintendent/Secretary-Treasurer" to "Superintendent." Since updating these policies will not cause any change in how they are applied, the updates are considered housekeeping changes that are not required to be recorded formally as amendments of the policies.
