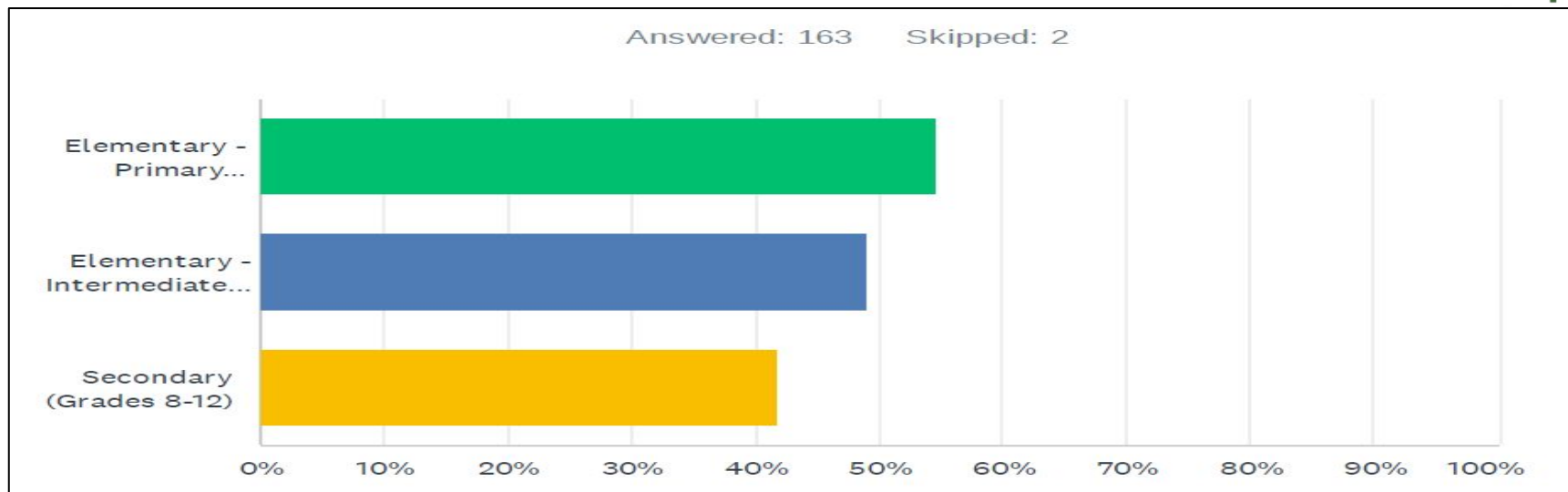

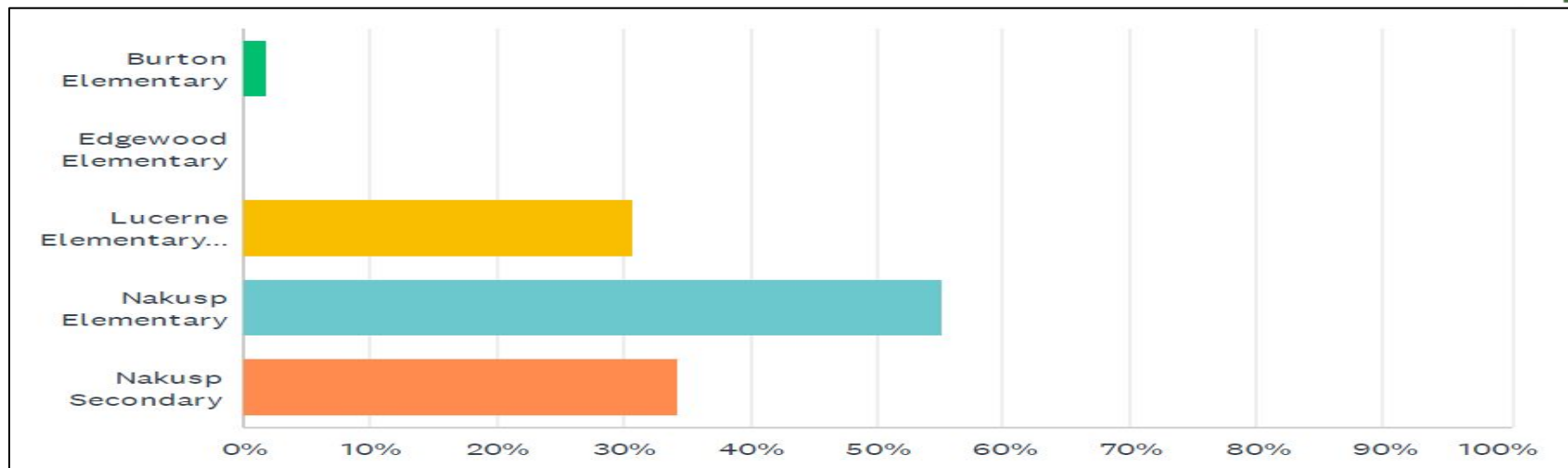


# What Grade(s) are your children?



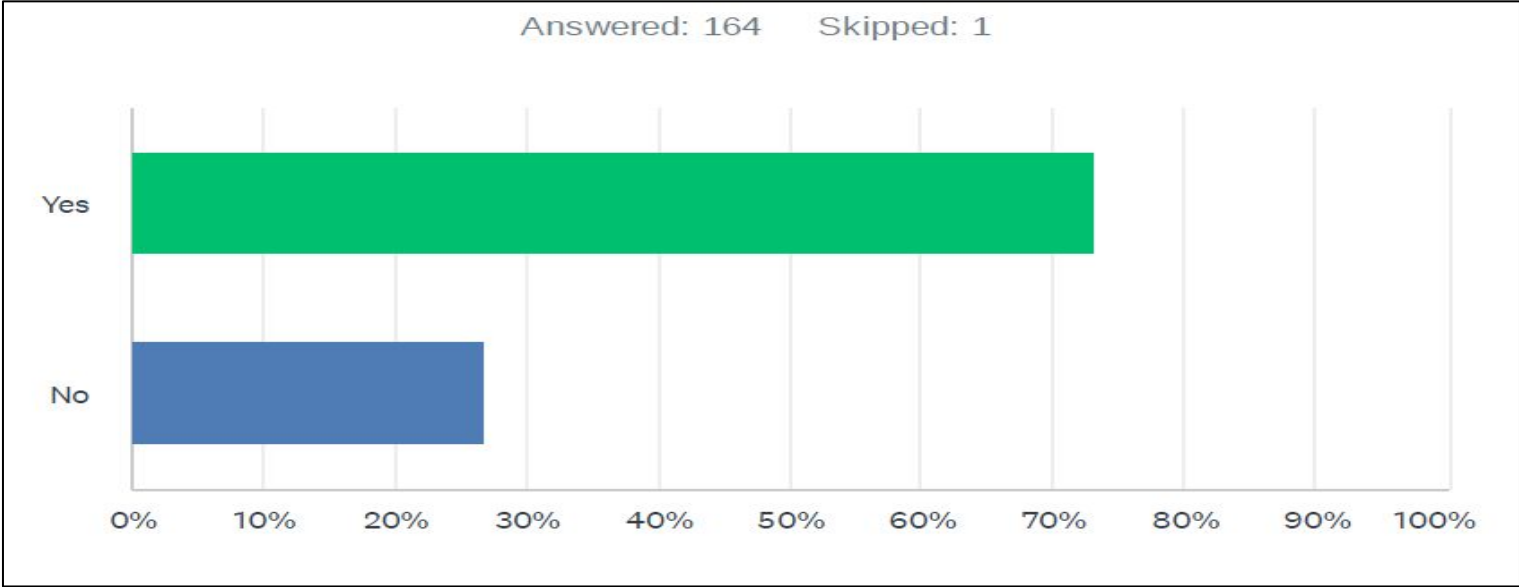

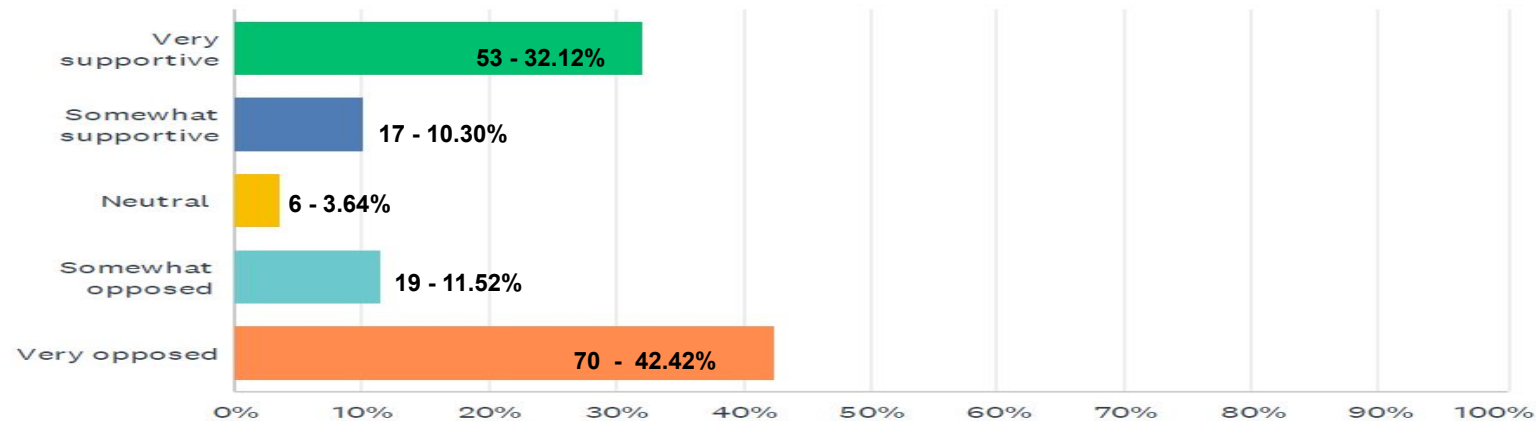

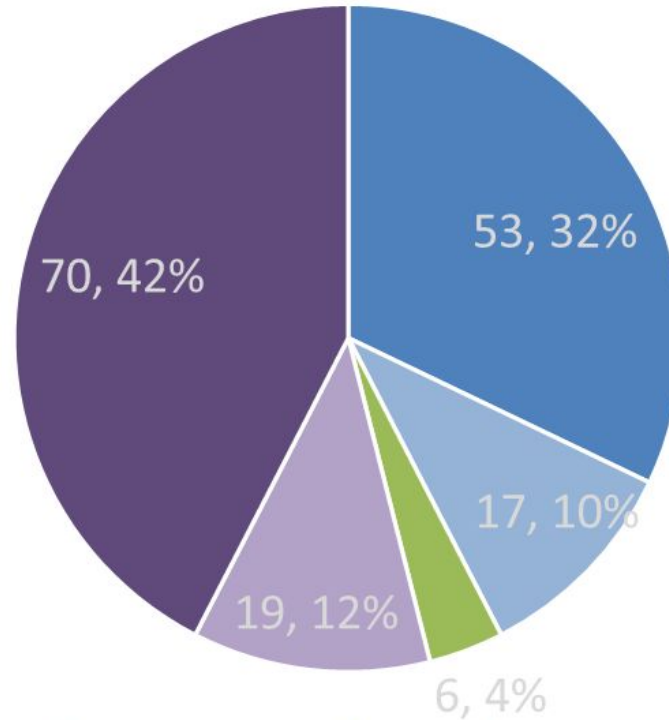

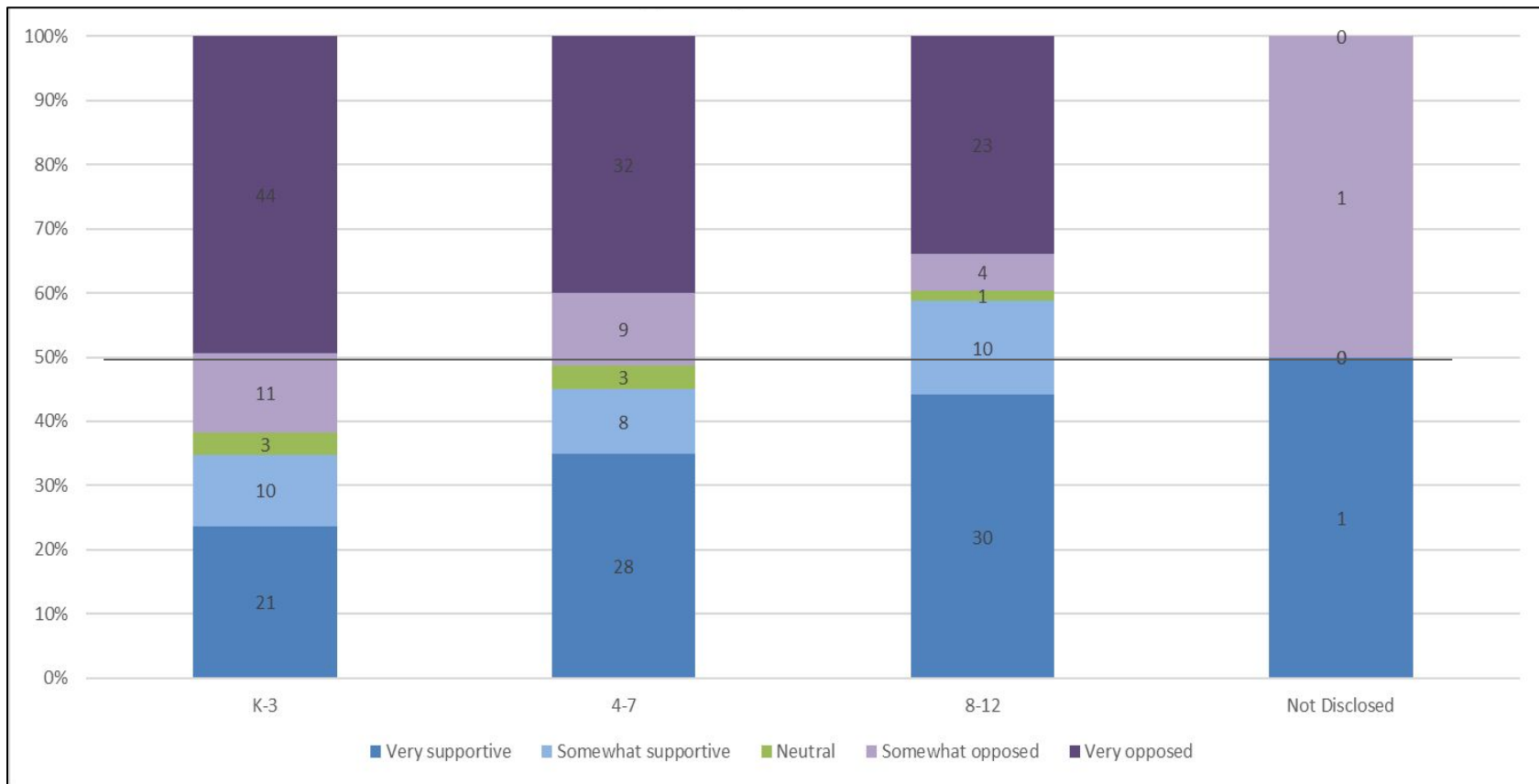
# Parent & Guardian Support - How do feel about the idea? (Equal weighting to each respondent)



■ Very supportive   ■ Somewhat supportive   ■ Neutral   ■ Somewhat opposed   ■ Very opposed

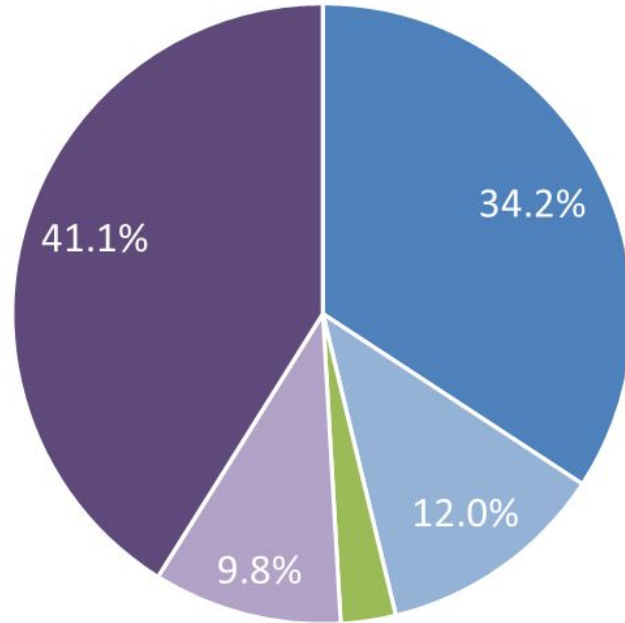


# Parent & Guardian Support by Grade



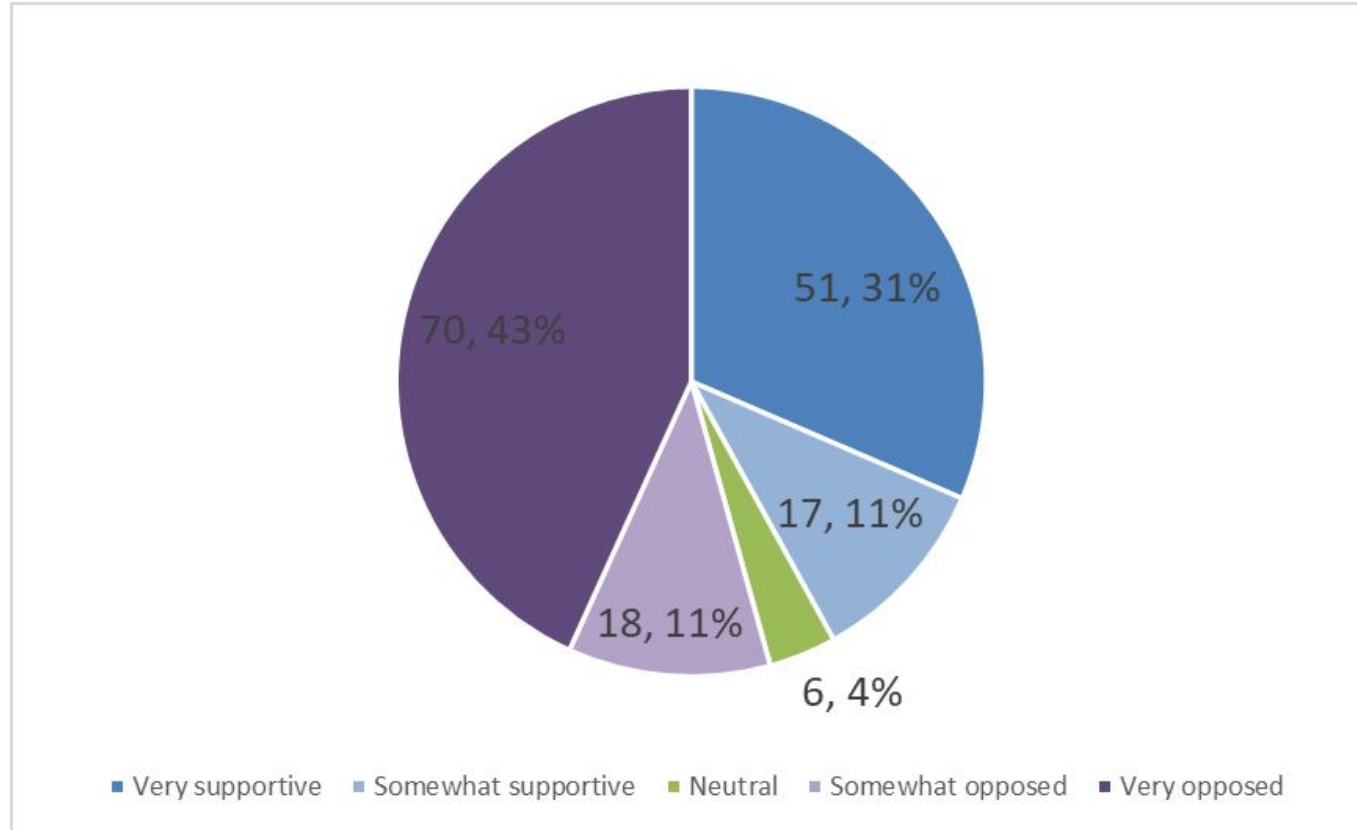


# Parent & Guardian Support - How do feel about the idea? (Equal weighting to Primary, Intermediate and Secondary)

# Parent & Guardian Support - How do feel about the idea (equal weighting to each school group over 10 respondents)?



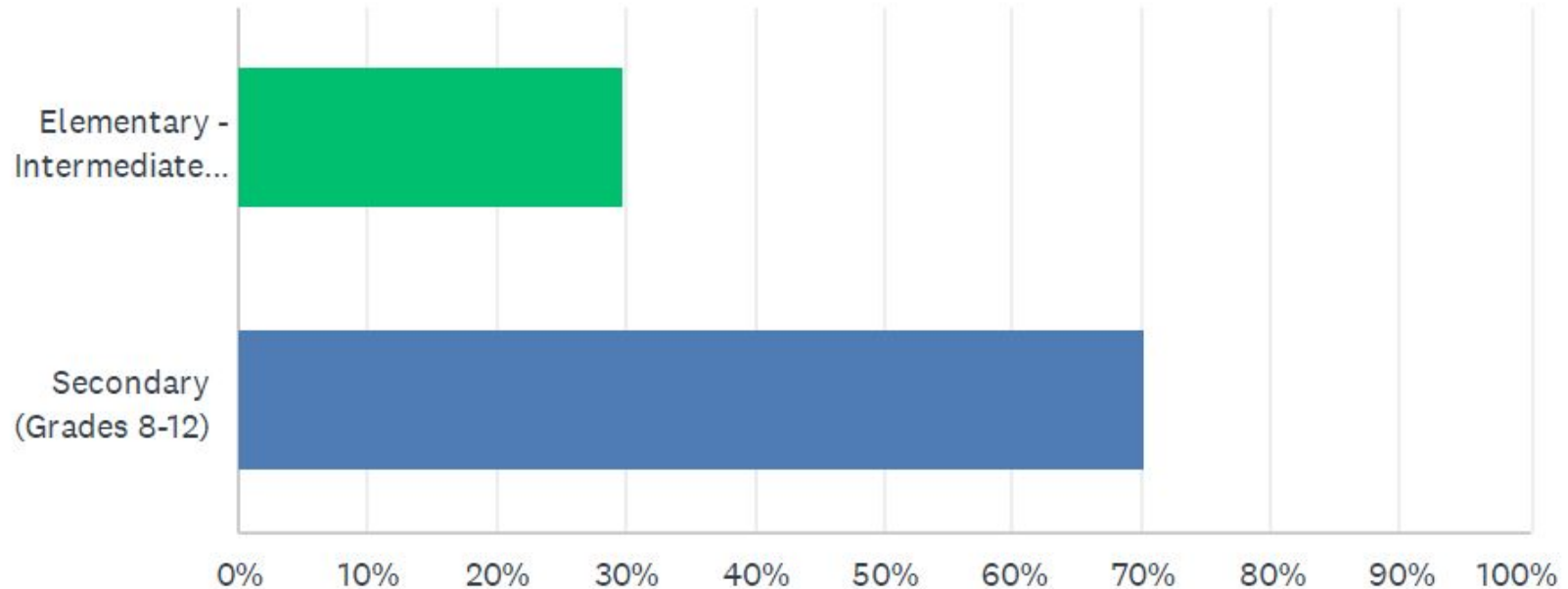

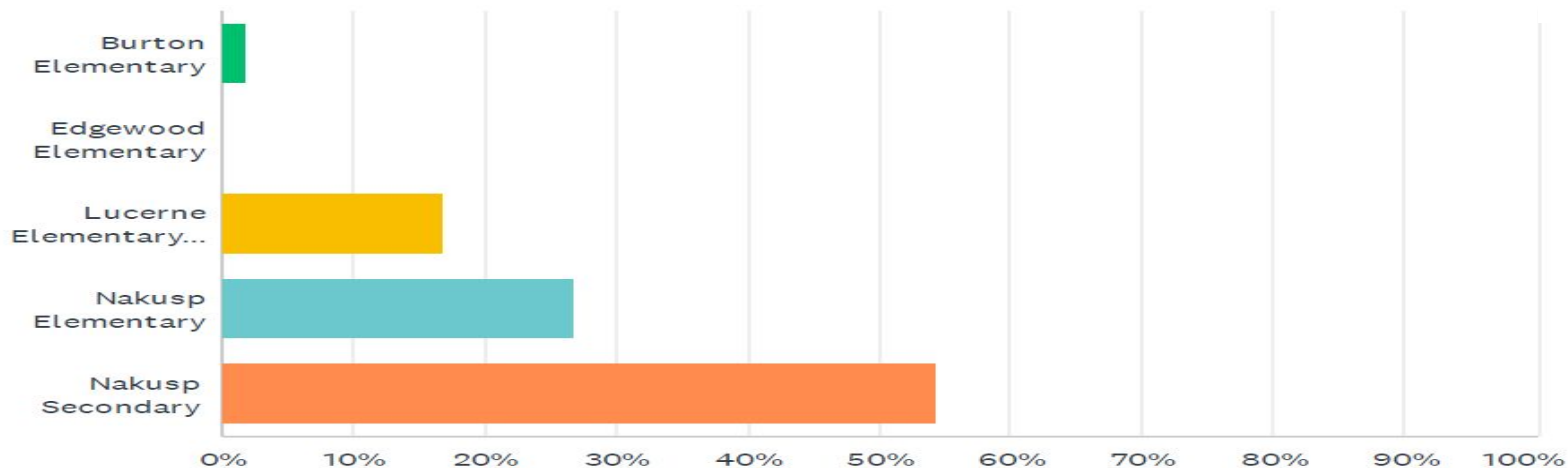
# Students - What Grade Are You In?

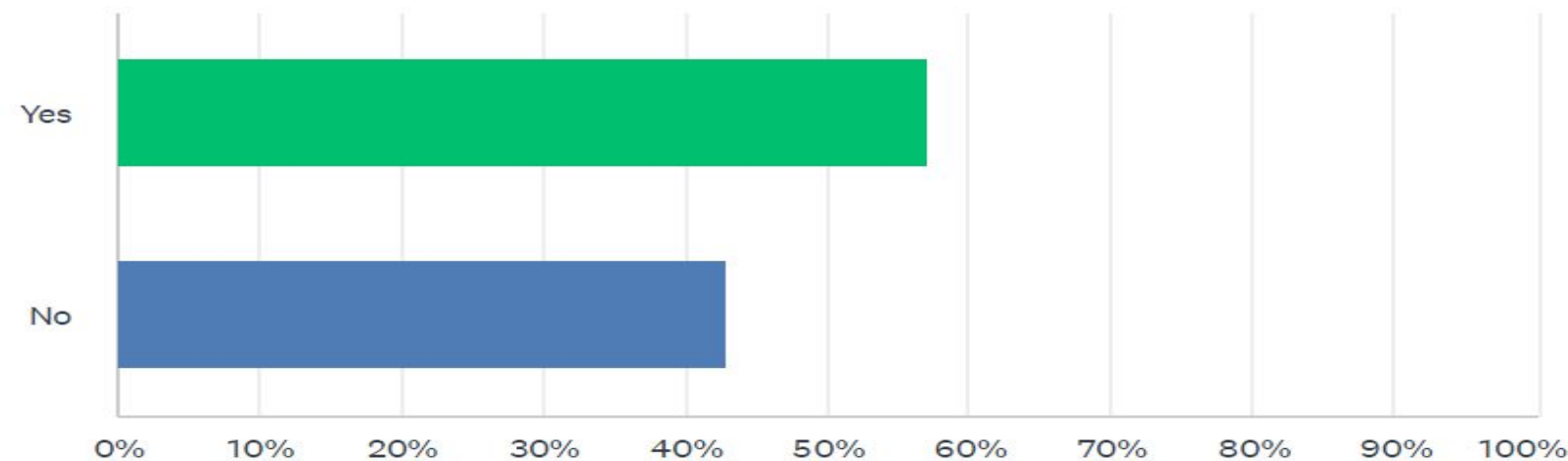

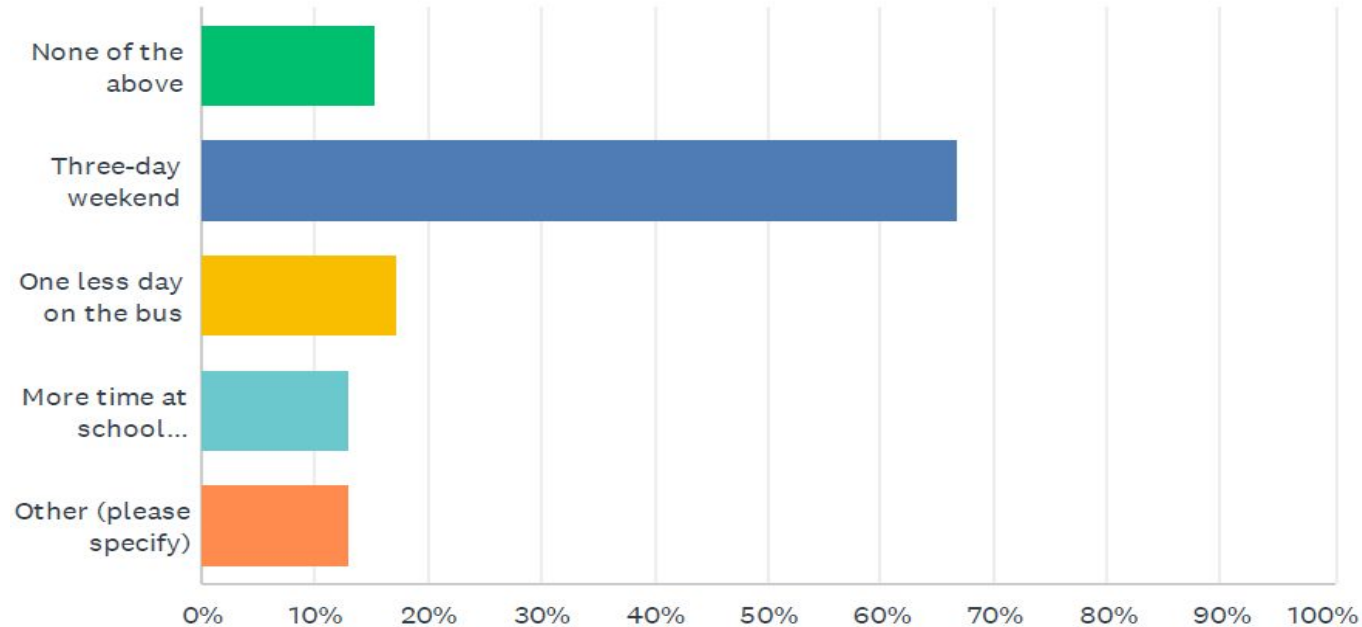

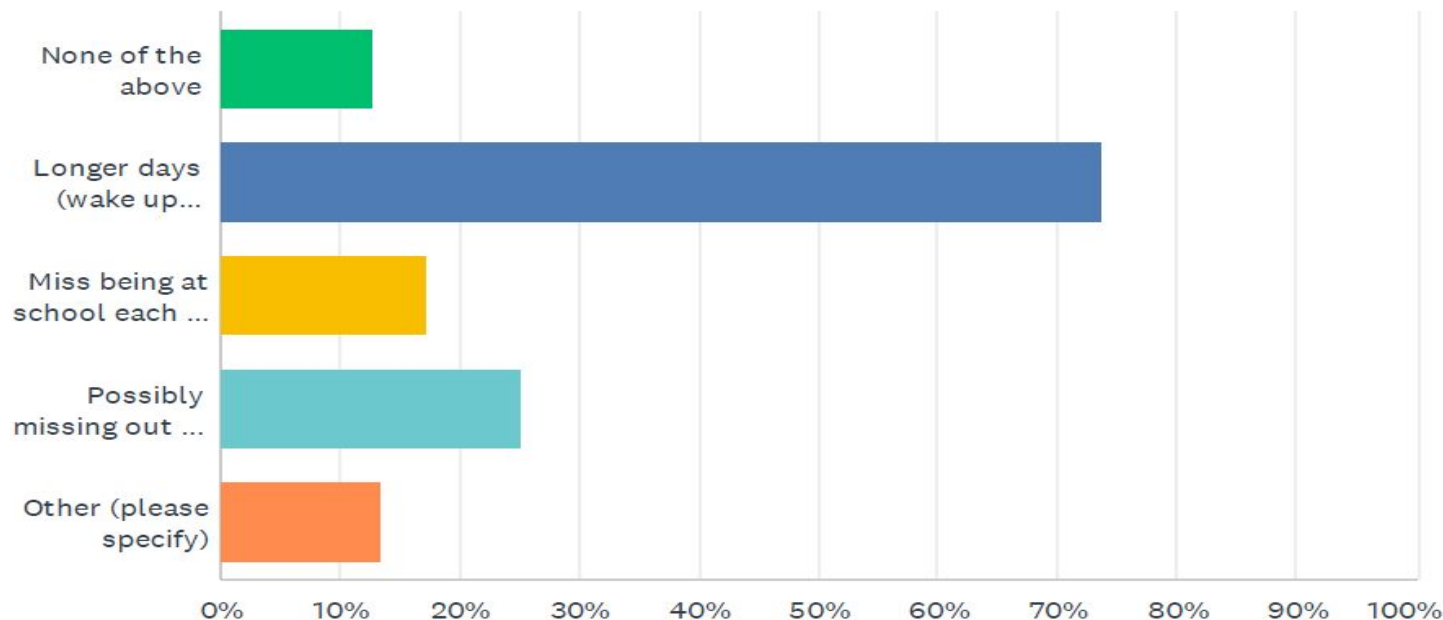

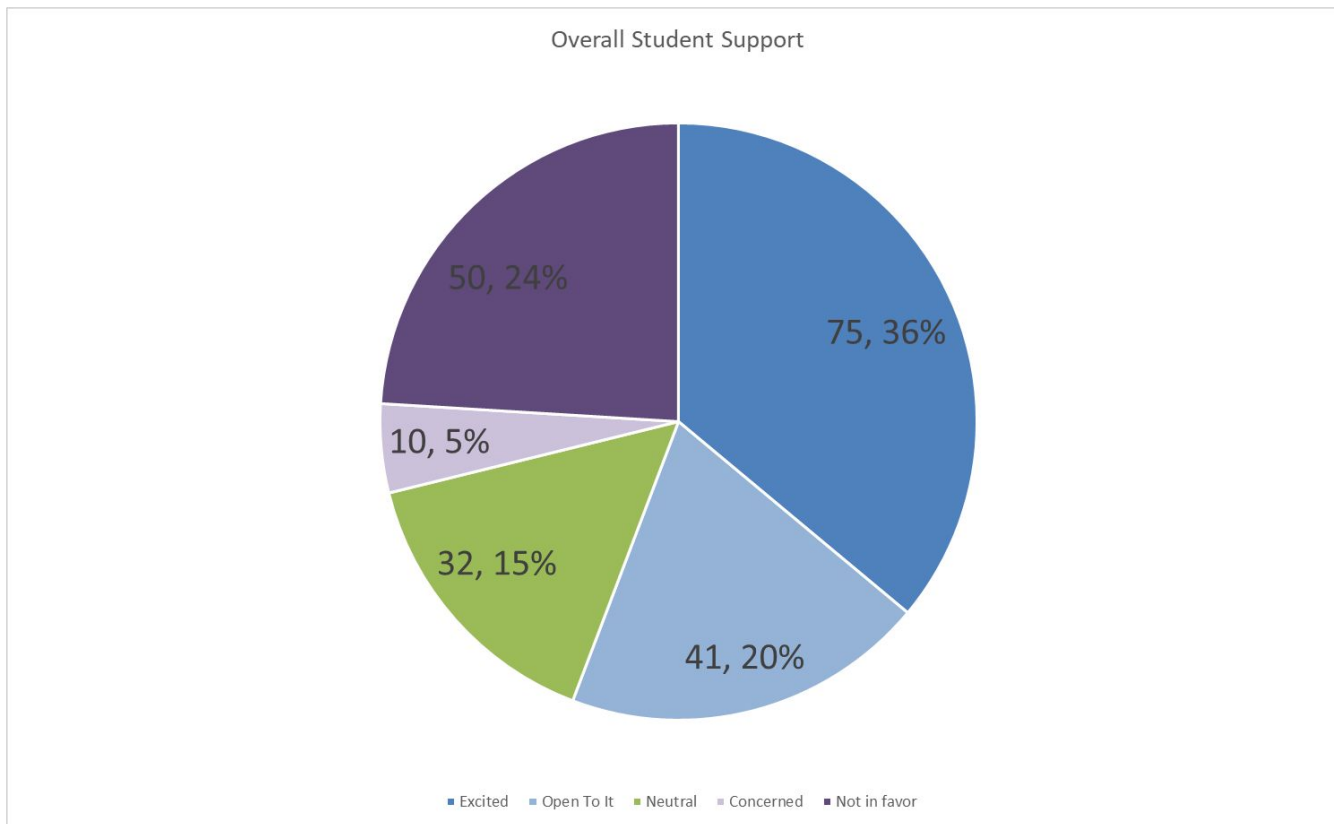

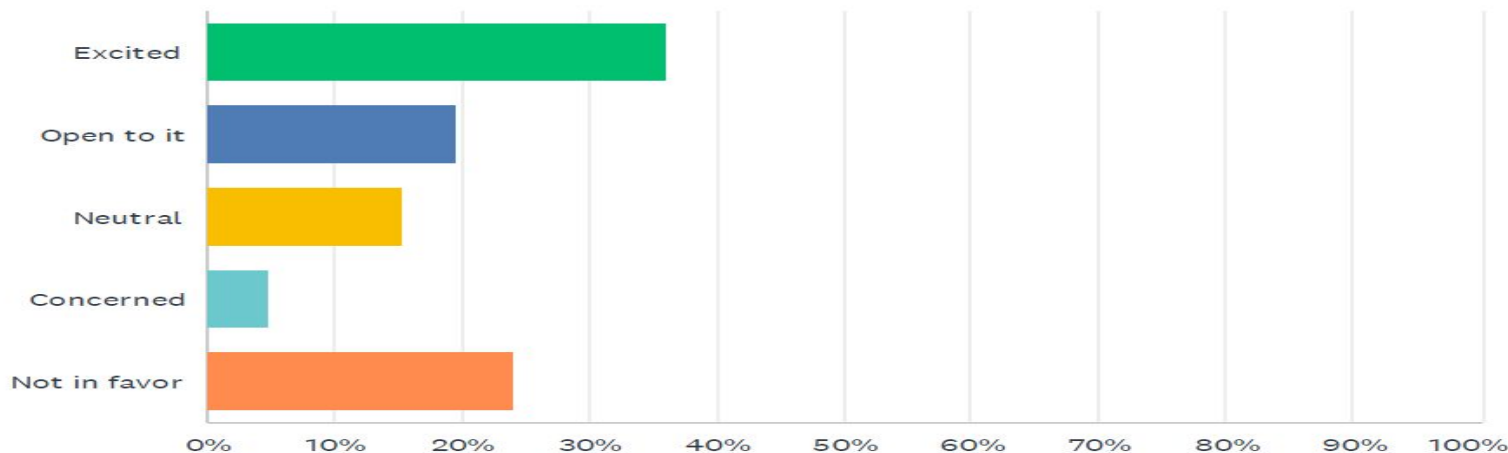




# Students - How do you feel about the idea of a 4-Day School week?

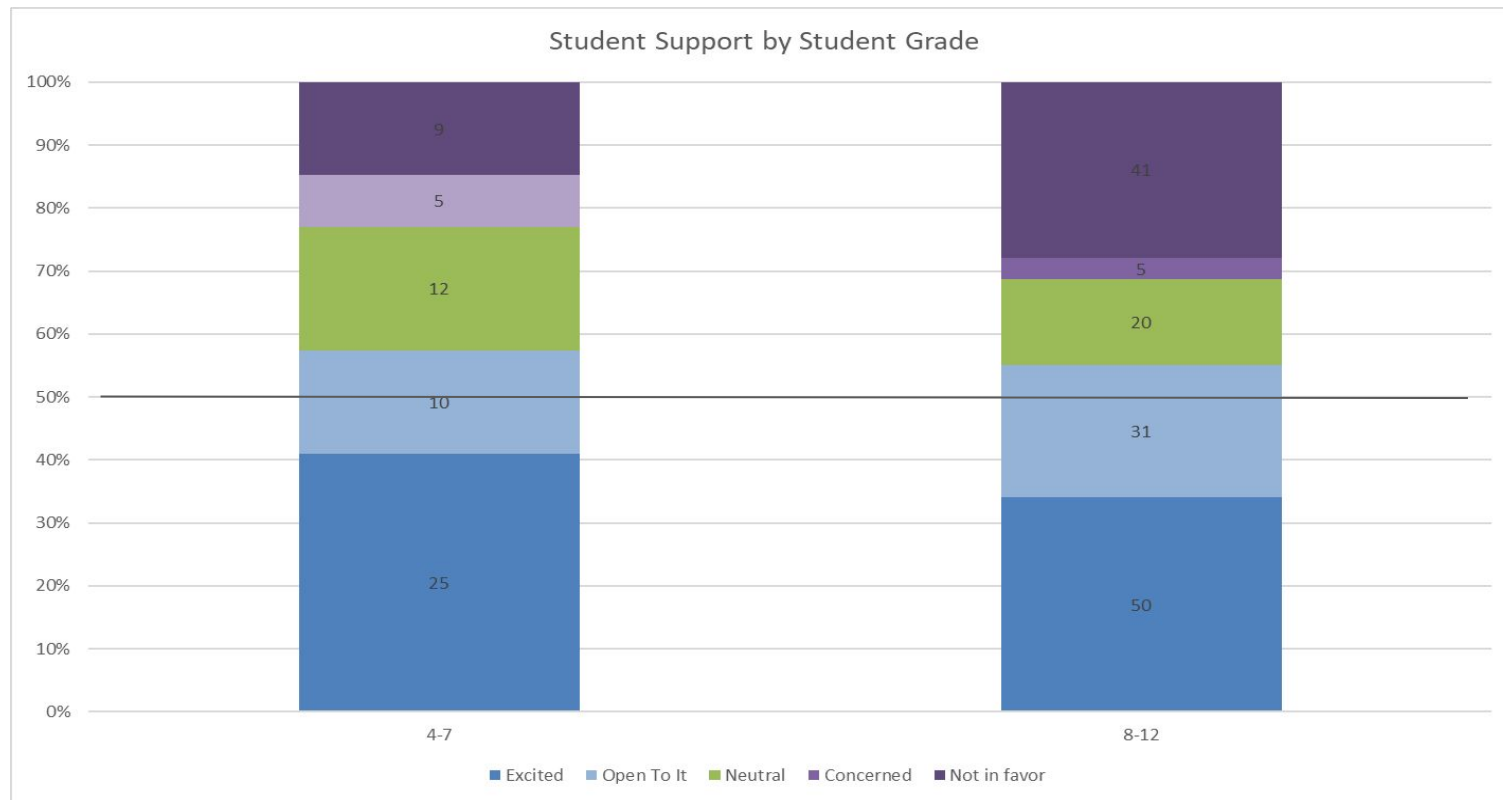

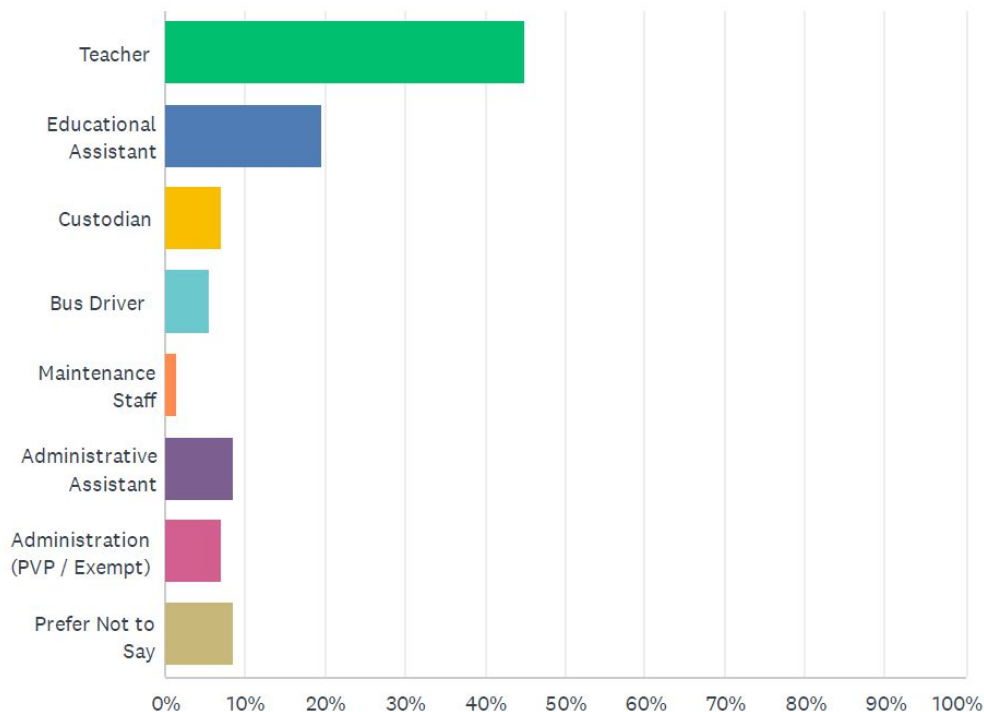

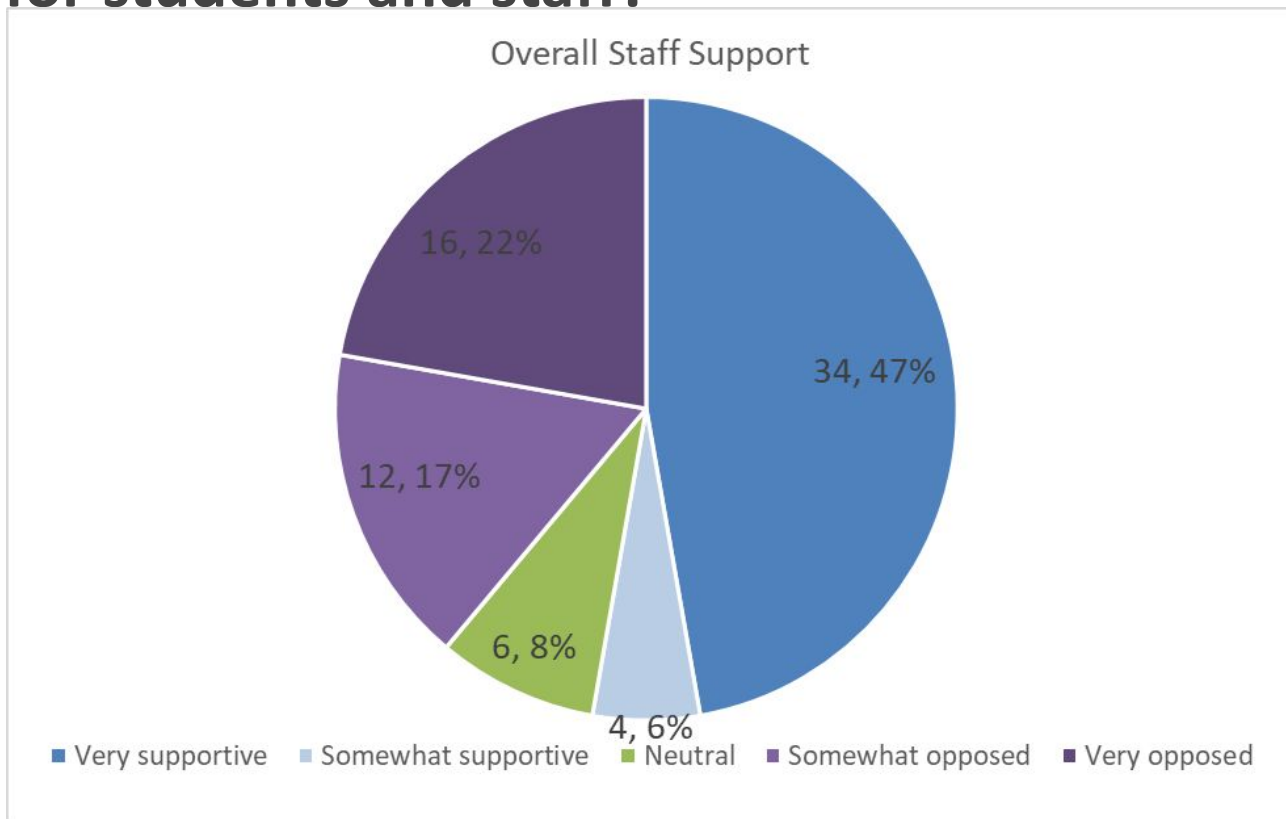

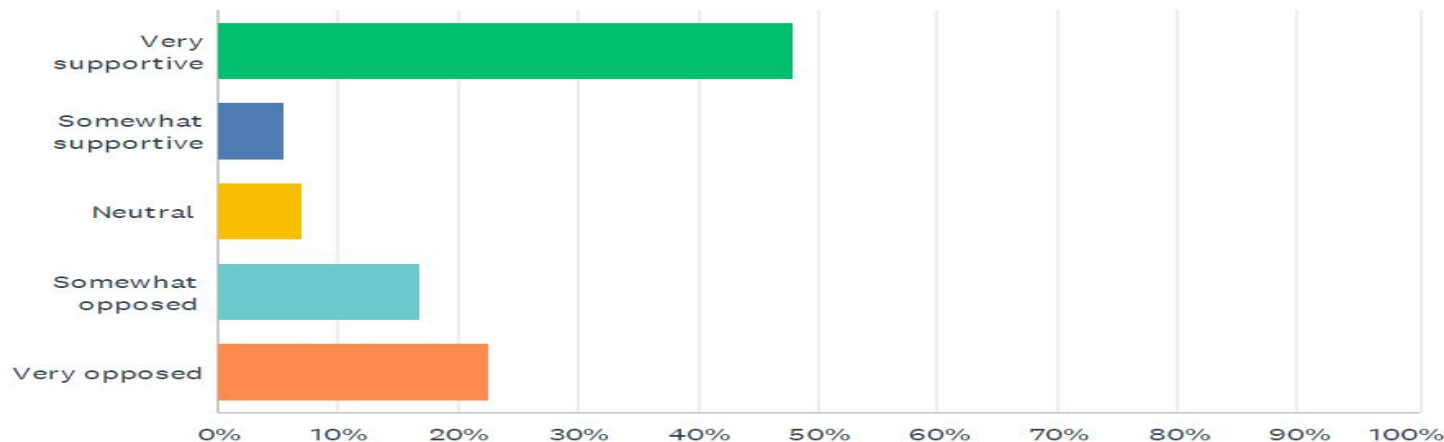

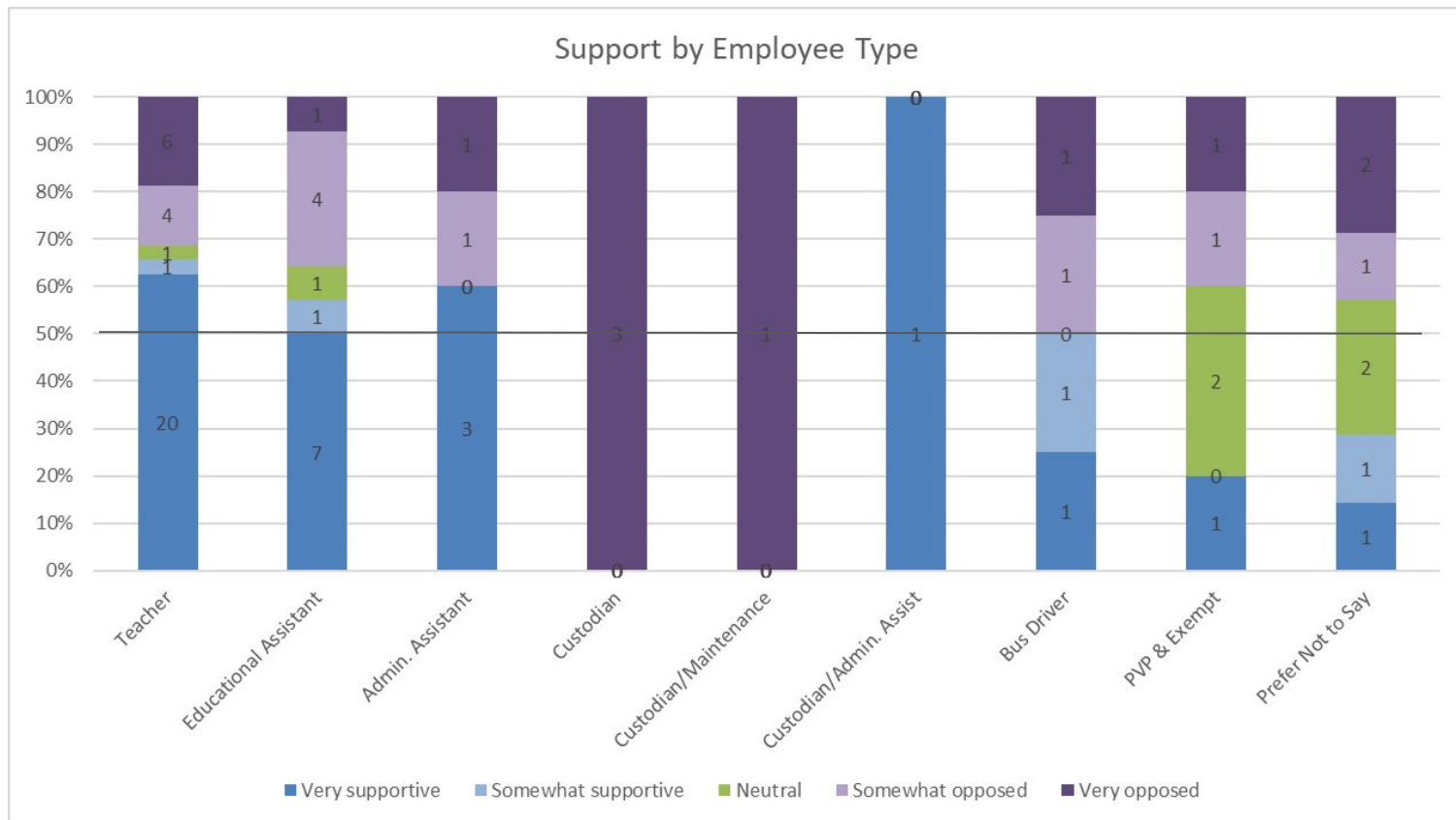
