Board of Education Bursary

- 1.1 The Board of Education Bursary recognizes the Grade 12 student(s) whose achievements best exemplify one or more of the district's priorities outlined in its strategic plan:

COMPETENCY: *Students are challenged to build their competency and character.*

HEALTH: *Students are enhancing their physical and mental health knowledge and skills for positive living and resiliency.*

ENVIRONMENT: *Students are learning about, enjoying, and caring for our unique rural environment.*

Qualifications for the Board of Education Bursary

- 2.1 Candidates for the Board of Education Bursary must:
- 2.1.1 Be a grade twelve student graduating from a secondary school in the District in June.
 - 2.1.2 Be a Canadian citizen, have landed immigrant status, or a valid student visa.
 - 2.1.3 Have achieved a grade average of at least C (60%) in Grades 11 and 12.
 - 2.1.4 Apply to the School Board Office on or before April 30th with an application form (attached to this protocol), a resume and school transcripts.
 - 2.1.5 If shortlisted, have an interview being prepared to provide compelling evidence as to how they meet the criteria in Section 1.1 above.
