Protocol 680.3 – Student Transportation – Transportation Assistance

- 1.1 To apply for transportation assistance, the student's parent or guardian must submit a Transportation Assistance Application form to their school each school year.
- 1.2 To qualify for transportation assistance a student must:
 - 1.2.1 Live within the boundaries of the District.
 - 1.2.2 Have no District student transportation services provided.
 - 1.2.3 Live beyond 2.5 kilometers from the nearest bus stop.
- 1.3 Full responsibility for safe transportation of the student to and from school, and having the appropriate insurance coverage, rests with the student's parent or guardian.
- 1.4 The amount of transportation assistance paid monthly, subject to the Maximum Daily Rate (defined below) is calculated as follows:

Transportation Distance x Trips (4) x Daily Kilometer Rate x Number of School Days

- 1.4.1 The Transportation Distance is the distance from the student's home to the closer of the student's catchment school or bus stop on a route to that school.
- 1.4.2 There are four "Trips" per day: a trip each way in the morning and again in the afternoon.
- 1.4.3 The transportation assistance paid will be based on the current District rate per kilometer. By default the rate is half of the CRA's per kilometre rate for kms > 5,000kms.
- 1.4.4 The Number of School Days is the number of days the student attended school, and parent or guardian transportation was provided.
- 1.4.5 The maximum daily rate is \$5.00 per school day, per family, for the school year.
