

SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 10 (ARROW LAKES) POLICY MANUAL

501 – Class Size and Composition

General

- 1.1 Class sizes will be determined following the School Act and the collective agreement between the Board and the Arrow Lakes Teacher Association.
- 1.2 The Board recognizes that, when organizing classrooms, multi-age classes and the diverse learning needs of students may impact student learning and teacher workload, and these factors are to be considered when determining student placement in classrooms and creating schedules and timetables.
- 1.3 Partners and stakeholders, including teachers and support staff, can provide input regarding potential ways to address class composition and complexity during annual budget consultations.

Authorization

- 1.4 The Superintendent is authorized to establish protocols and practices to:
 - 1.4.1 Meet the collective agreement requirements between the Board and the Arrow Lakes Teachers Association regarding class sizes.
 - 1.4.2 Assess the diverse and unique learning needs of students.
 - 1.4.3 Determine the placement of students in classrooms.
 - 1.4.4 Determine schedules and class timetables.
