



SCHOOL DISTRICT NO.10 (ARROW LAKES) POLICY MANUAL

671 – Video Surveillance

1. General

- 1.1. The Board of Education recognizes that controlled video surveillance can contribute to the safety of students, employees and others on district premises and can be a valuable tool to deter destructive acts, theft and/or other criminal activities.
- 1.2. The Board recognizes its obligations to protect the privacy rights of individuals and that these rights must be balanced and respected as part of a video surveillance process.
- 1.3. It is the purview of the Board that video surveillance as a means of enhancing safety and/or enacting deterrence is implemented in circumstances where it is reasonably necessary and proportionate to the identified purpose, and in accordance with the School Act and Freedom of Information and Protection and Privacy Act (FIPPA).

2. Authorization

- 2.1. The Superintendent shall establish protocols to implement this policy.
